## These are our Favorite Five things to support learning this week:

- 1. MATH: Career Sort game
  - 1. Cut out all the cards. Have kids or older siblings help.
  - 2. Lay the Career cards face up on a table. Lay Career Object cards face down.
  - 3. Start by talking with your child about what each career does. Then, have her pick up a Career Object card, and match it with the right Career which uses it. Describing what the object is will help build young children's vocabulary!
- 2. WORD WORK BEGINNING SOUNDS: Play GO FIND IT!
  - 1. Cut out the picture cards. Have kids or older siblings help.
  - 2. Remind child that the beginning sound is the first sound we hear when we say a word. Give sample words and help child hear the beginning sound. For example, say "Let's say 'dog'. At the beginning of 'dog' I hear a 'ddd' sound, 'ddddog'. You say 'ddddog'."
  - 3. Have child choo
- 3. EXPRESS STORY TELLING: Story telling jar......
- 4. READ: Read aloud 20 mins or watch Michelle Obama read The Gruffalo.
- 5. **WRITING:** Write the letters <u>V</u>, <u>W</u> and <u>X</u> in front of your child, then have him write the letters.

Practice naming and writing these letters through the week. Review <u>A through U</u> from before.
